INTRODUCTION**

This Statistical First Release announces the planned schedule for the publication of statistics by DCSF for the period October 2007 to September 2008. This forms part of the arrangements set out in the Department's Compliance Statement with the National Statistics Code of Practice: Release Practices Protocol

KEY POINTS

The schedule lists the statistical publications (First Releases, Bulletins and Volumes) to be published in each of the next six months and provides a provisional programme for the following six months, except in the case of SFRs with fixed days for publication which are already identified in this SFR. The next schedule is due to be announced in a Statistical First Release in March 2008. The date of issue for each publication will be announced towards the end of the previous month in the monthly Press Release Calendar, published by Office for National Statistics.

If it proves necessary to change the pre-announced date of any publication (i.e. the month for publications planned in each of the next six months or the date of issue for the calendar month ahead), an explanation will be given both in the Press Release Calendar and on the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF) Research and Statistics website at <http://www.dcsf.gov.uk/rsgateway/index.shtml>. Any explanation will be provided as far in advance of the planned date of publication as possible.

Most of the statistical publications included in this schedule were published previously by the former Department for Education and Skills (DfES). With the Machinery of Government changes in June 2007, some of the publications previously published by DfES will continue to be published by the Department for Innovation, Universities and Skills (DIUS).
